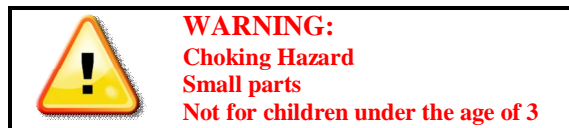


# How to build a Yellow-tailed Kibby!

## Parts



1 red rectangle



1 red curved piece



1 red eye square



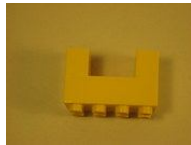
2 orange squares



2 skinny orange rectangles



1 curved orange piece



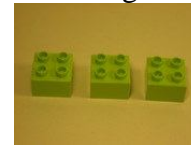
1 yellow u-shaped piece



1 yellow eye square



1 flat yellow rectangle



3 light green squares



1 light green rectangle



1 green rectangle



2 blue squares



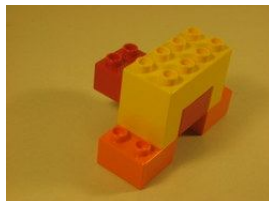
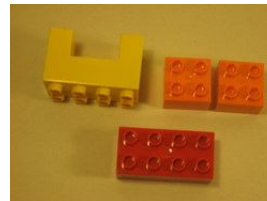
1 blue rectangle



1 light blue rectangle

## Instructions

**Let's build the body first!**  
**These are the parts you will need:**



### Step 1:

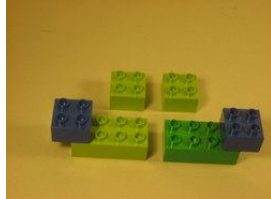
Turn the yellow u-shaped piece upside-down and attach the 2 orange squares.

### Step 2:

Attach the red rectangle to the underside of the upside-down yellow u-shaped piece.

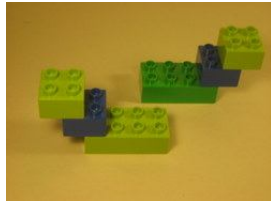
Set the body aside.

**Now let's build the wings! These are the parts you will need:**



**Step 3:**

Attach one blue square to the light green rectangle and one blue square to the green rectangle.



**Step 4:**

Attach one light green square to each of the blue squares.

Set the wings aside.

**Now let's build the face! These are the parts you will need:**



**Step 5:**

Attach the blue rectangle to the top of the curved orange piece.



**Step 6:**

Attach the red eye square and the yellow eye square to the blue rectangle.



**Step 7:**

Attach the skinny orange rectangles to the eye squares to make the ears.

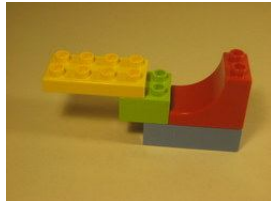
Set the face aside.

**Now let's build the tail end! These are the parts you will need:**



**Step 8:**

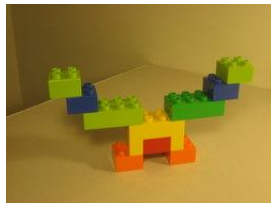
Attach the red curved piece to the light blue rectangle.



**Step 9:**

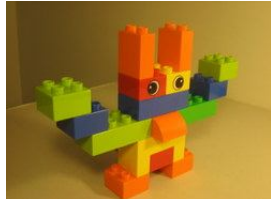
Attach the light green square to the light blue rectangle then attach the flat yellow rectangle to the light green square.

**We're almost there! Now grab all five sections: The body, the wings, the face, and the tail end.**



**Step 10:**

Attach each wing to the body.



**Step 11:**

Attach the face to the body and wings.



**Step 12:**

Attach the tail end to the body.

**You did it!
